

San Diego CTE Community Collaborative Committee Project Management Group

Description

As mandated by the state, the San Diego Community Collaborative operates a steering committee consisting of community partners from education and industry who meet to provide planning, coordination and broad advisory oversight of the projects funded through the SB 70 CTE initiative. The committee will focus on strengthening capacity to implement and sustain new CTE programs and practices within the local and regional service area of the Collaborative.

Functions and Responsibilities:

1. Disseminate CTE information to internal and external stakeholders
2. Provide oversight and evaluation of SDCCD Community Collaborative projects
3. Identify needs and gaps in current and future CTE projects and partnerships that could be better served as a sub-set of this larger CTE Community Collaborative initiative
4. Link funded projects with new funding opportunities when possible to sustain effective CTE programs and practices at the local and regional levels.
5. Annually review the functions, responsibilities and outcomes of the CTE Community Collaborative and make recommendations to ensure viable, long-term sustainability.
